Facilities for visiting groups.

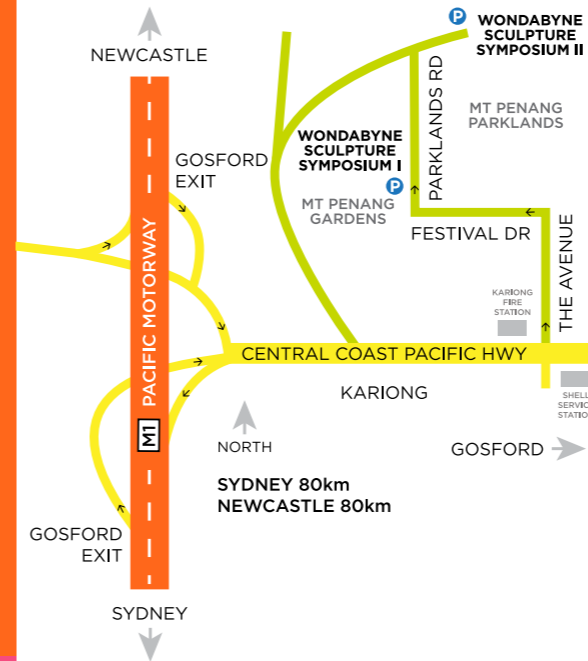
- The Waterfall Café offers light meals and refreshments for up to 60 people

'A Moment in Time' Historical Bus Tour

Operating for nearly 100 years as a facility for juvenile offenders, Mt Penang Parklands has a very rich story to tell.

Take a fascinating journey from the days of old when the site was chosen as the Gosford Farm Home for Boys. From a tent city to a working farm with prize winning cattle and a burgeoning trade school.



This tour brings the voices of the past to life with interesting stories, anecdotes and vivid imagery. 90 to 100 boys worked on the 681 acre 'industrial farm', gaining skills in carpentry and agriculture. Many of buildings seen today were built with the assistance of local builders.

Walk instead?

'A Moment in Time' is available as a walking tour upon request. Groups will need to be physically fit, as the tour covers approximately four kilometres.

Mt Penang Gardens Walking Tour

Over 8 hectares showcasing native flora. There is something in flower during every season at Mt Penang Gardens.

Explore the beautiful Gardens with a friendly Blue Thumb guide who provides information on the garden's creative design, the twelve themed garden rooms, its clever use of water and seasonal highlights.



The paths are mostly suitable for flat, easy walking, with some alternative routes for walking frames or wheel chairs. There is no motorised transport available within the gardens.

Tour times can be shortened or lengthened to suit your own timetable.



Wondabyne Sculpture Tour - Symposia I and II

In 1987, sculptors from all over the world came together for the first Australian International Sculpture Symposium in stone.

Initiated by Australian sculptor Lawrence Beck, the sculptors created their works of art at Wondabyne, a small, picturesque train stop along the Hawkesbury River.



Beautiful sandstone was donated from Gosford Quarries and the sculptures were handed over to the people of Australia as a bicentennial gift from the artists. It was a great success and a second international symposium was held at Mt Penang in 1988, again under the leadership of Lawrence Beck.

Today the magnificent sculptures of Symposium 1 and 2 and be found in the lovely Mt Penang Parklands and Gardens. They are major cultural and historical assets to the heritage of our region.
